The AmeriHealth Caritas Next Behavioral Health Bootcamp ECHO program exists to:

1. Provide education to increase screening and treatment of behavioral health disorders among members in physical health settings.
2. Help providers recognize symptoms, adaptations, or somatic complaints in response to a traumatic experience.
3. Build skills to successfully engage members in treatment through motivational interviewing and harm reduction interventions.
